On Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> February, we're welcoming 8 new lions to the pride with a special awakening (eye dotting) ceremony at the temple at 9am. It is a very auspicious event not to be missed. The dotting ceremony is undertaken to awaken the lions.

Evil spirits are scared away upon seeing their own reflection in the lions mirror shield situated on its forehead. The eyes are dotted so that the spirit can foresee good and evil. The mouth, ears and horn followed by the rest of the body from the back of the head to the end of the tail. After the spirit has entered the lion's body the eyes and mouth are opened. The red bow tied around the horn symbolises courage and honour.
